Examination for Registration to Practise Medicine (ERPM)

PART A and PART D: 2020

The Sri Lanka Medical Council will receive applications for the above examination from **Monday 24th August 2020 to Monday 07th September 2020 from 9.30 a.m to 1.00 p.m.** only on each working day. The application forms can be obtained from the Council Office and the SLMC website. Receipt of applications will close on **Monday 07th September 2020 at 1.00 p.m.**

Eligibility:

- (a) Citizens of Sri Lanka who have obtained approval of the Sri Lanka Medical Council for the MBBS or equivalent degree from a foreign medical school recognized by the Council. (Applicants are strongly advised to apply for the approval of the MBBS degree **URGENTLY** if it has not been completed yet.)

- (b) Candidates who have previously sat the examination and have not completed ERPM Parts A and/or D.

The new format of the examination has been introduced from 2014 as follows:

Part A:

Paper 1 Medicine including Psychiatry

Paper 2 Paediatrics including Psychiatry

Paper 3 Surgery

Paper 4 Obstetrics & Gynaecology

Each paper will have 25 MCQs of True/False type and 25 Single Best Answer Questions, a total of 50 Questions in each paper.

Part D:

Paper 5 Community Medicine

Paper 6 Forensic Medicine

Each paper will have 30 MCQs of the True/False type.

Note: Candidates should apply for all subjects of ERPM Part A and Part D which have NOT been passed in previous examinations.

Details of the ERPM process, the subject curricula and instructions for application are available on the website. The dates and venue of the examination will be notified later.
