Notice to prospective candidates for the Examination to Register to Practice Medicine (ERPM) and Examination to Practice Dental Surgery (ERPDS) in Sri Lanka

It is mandatory that prospective candidates who are to sit the ERPM or ERPDS obtain the approval of the MBBS degree or BDS (DA) by the SLMC. The essential requirements for DA are:


- Being a citizen of Sri Lanka
- Possess the MBBS or BDS degree from a Medical / Dental school approved by the SLMC which is active during the period of training
- Confirmation by the training institution directly with the SLMC of the degree awarded and the Transcripts / Mark sheets.

The Process:


1. Apply on-line for DA (essential) by down loading from the SLMC web site www.mc.lk the Application form with Declaration and attested by an authorized officer of the Sri Lanka High Commission or embassy, Justice of Peace or a Commissioner of Oaths in the country of residence, while retaining copies.
2. Present in person with photocopies:
 - 2.1. Original Degree or Diploma Certificate (other documents on the degree awarded are NOT accepted)
 - 2.2. Translation into English of the degree certificate (as required)
 - 2.3. Transcript or Mark Sheet of the candidate performance during the training
 - 2.4. Internship Certificate if applicable
 - 2.5. Eligibility letter
 - 2.6. National Identity Card
 - 2.7. Original Passport(s) with photocopies of the main information page and all pages indicating visas for entry and exit into the foreign country and to Sri Lanka during the period of training. If more than one passport has been issued photocopies of the endorsement on Page 2 of each passport are to be submitted.
 - 2.8. The payment voucher duly certified by the bank that the relevant payment of Rs.7,500/= has been made to the A/C No:0000371208 of the Sri Lanka Medical Council through any branch of the Bank of Ceylon in Sri Lanka.
 - 2.9. One passport size colour photograph of the front view of the face against a white background on good quality matt paper.
3. **Candidates residing overseas:** The above documents may be sent via courier or a relative with a covering letter from the prospective candidate.

The originals of these documents should be presented in person by the applicant after arrival in Sri Lanka.

4. The SLMC will process the DA application after receiving confirmation of the degree from the Medical / Dental school.
5. The SLMC will prepare the degree approval letter with an ERPMS / ERPDS registration number which will be handed over **only in person to the prospective candidate for the ERPMS / ERPDS.**
6. Candidates are advised to refer to the instructions for application for the ERPMS Part A and Part D is given in the SLMC web site www.mc.lk. Or www.srilankamedicalcouncil.org.
7. The national guidelines regarding the prevention of Covid – 19 including those for quarantine will be strictly followed. The SLMC cannot be responsible for delays or any other effects in this regard.
