- Paper 2 – Tuesday 3 August 2010 – 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. – Obstetrics & Gynaecology**
- Paper 3 – Wednesday 4 August 2010 – 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. – Paediatrics**
- Paper 4 – Thursday 5 August – 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. – Surgery**
- Paper 5 - Thursday 5 August 2010 – 1.00 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. – Community Medicine,
Forensic Medicine
and Pathology**

Questions in Psychiatry would be included in Medicine and Paediatrics papers.

Examination Fees

Rs. 1000/- per paper or

Rs. 500/- for each component of Paper 5 (for ‘Old Format’ candidates only)

Duly completed Application Forms with payment slips certified by the bank should be handed over to the Council office. Applications of candidates who are abroad at present would be accepted but they should send the original copy by post or courier before the exam.
