Examination for Registration to Practise Medicine
(ERPM) PART A: 18-21 November 2013

Applications for the above examination will be received by the Sri Lanka Medical Council from Monday 9 September 2013 to Friday 27 September 2013 from 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on each working day. The application forms can be obtained from the Council office and the SLMC Website. The closing date for receipt of applications will be **Friday, 27 September 2013 at 1.00 p.m.**

Eligibility:

- (a) Citizens of Sri Lanka who have been granted approval by the Sri Lanka Medical Council for the MBBS or equivalent degree obtained from a foreign medical school recognized by the Council; and
- (b) Candidates who have sat the examination before but have not completed it.

The format of the examination has been changed by the UGC: the common MCQ papers in each 'clinical' subject – Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics and Surgery will have 20 MCQs of the True/False type and 30 MCQs of the Single Best Answer (SBA) type, a total of 50 questions in each paper.

The format of the combined paper (Community Medicine, Pathology and Forensic Medicine) will not be changed. There will be 10 MCQs of the True/False type in each of the three subjects – a total of 30 MCQs.
